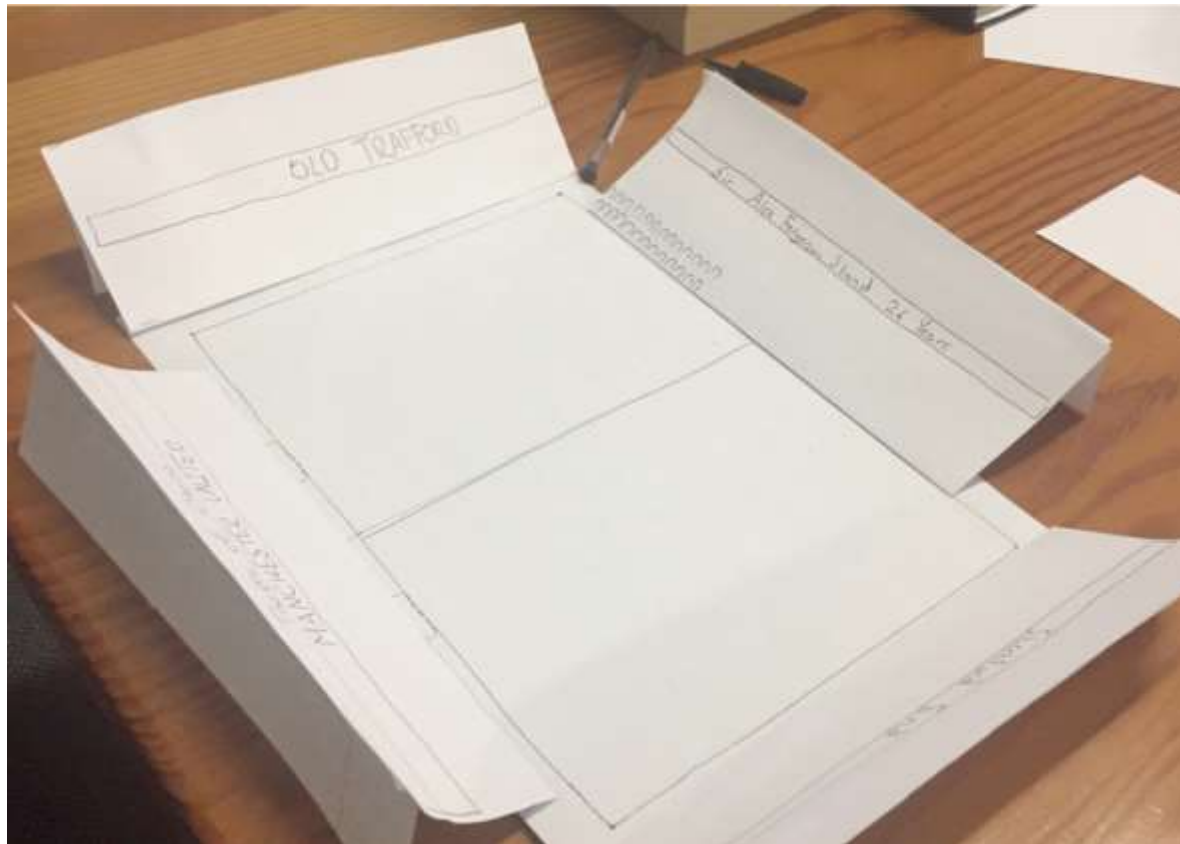
- A space at the table for all
